NOTICE OF INTENT TO ISSUE PERMIT FOR A SOLID WASTE CLASS III DISPOSAL FACILITY

The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC), Division of Solid Waste Management (DSWM), has tentatively decided to issue a solid waste disposal facility permit major modification to North Memphis Landfill, Inc. This major modification will consolidate two existing landfill cells resulting in an increase in airspace through a vertical expansion. The facility, identified as North Memphis Landfill (DML790000109), is located in Shelby County at 382 Klinke Road, Memphis, Tennessee (latitude 35°13'30" N/ longitude 90°02'42" W). The official responsible for operation of the facility is Mr. Marvin Frick, Manager, 382 Klinke Road, Memphis, TN 38127, (901-358-9544).

This permit would authorize construction, operation, and closure, and post-closure care of the existing class III disposal facility for the disposal of farming wastes, landscaping and land clearing wastes, construction/demolition wastes, shredded automotive tires, and/or certain wastes having similar characteristics and approved in writing by TDEC.

No hazardous wastes, as regulated by the Tennessee Hazardous Waste Management Act (Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 68-212-101, et. seq.) and the Rules adopted pursuant to the Act, shall be accepted for disposal at this facility.

Following an in-depth review of the facility's application, DSWM has made a preliminary determination that it meets the applicable requirements of Tennessee Rule Chapter 0400-11-01, Solid Waste Processing and Disposal. DSWM invites the public to review the application and draft permit and submit written comments during a 45-day comment period ending **July 5, 2016**. Pending consideration of any contrary technical information received, DSWM intends to issue this permit.

Comments must be received by 4:30 p.m. CDT on **Tuesday, July 5, 2016** to assure consideration. A request for a public hearing must be in writing and state the nature of the issues proposed to be raised in the hearing. If a hearing is scheduled, another notice will be published at least 15 days in advance.

After considering all public comments, DSWM will make a final decision to issue or deny the permit. DSWM will provide notice of the final permit decision and a Response to Comments addressing all significant input received on the draft permit to the applicant and to each person who has submitted written comments. These documents will also be available online and at the repositories listed above.


