Commissioner Mark Billingsley was appointed to the Shelby County Board of Commissioners on January 13, 2014 to represent District 4, Position 2 and was elected in August, 2014 to serve the people of the newly formed District 4 which is comprised of the City of Germantown, South Cordova, Southwind and Windyke areas of Shelby County.

Mark is the Director of Major Gifts and Transplant Philanthropy at Methodist Healthcare Foundation. He has been a leader in the nonprofit sector for over 20 years serving as an Executive Director as well as a Director of Marketing and Development. He is a resident of Germantown, Tennessee and grew up in Memphis. He is a graduate of the St. Michael's Elementary School, Christian Brothers High School and the University of Memphis.

Prior to being a Shelby County Commissioner, he was elected as an Alderman in the City of Germantown from 2008-2012 and also served as a Vice-Mayor.
