

Section 16-51. Severability of Parts of Articles

The provisions of this Act are hereby declared to be severable, and if any sections, provisions, clauses, or parts be held unconstitutional or void, then the remainder of this Act shall continue in full force and effect, it being the legislative intent that this Act would have been adopted even if such unconstitutional or void matter had not been included therein.
