WHO: The Memphis Area Association of Governments (MAAG)

WHAT: Broadcast and print media will have an opportunity to meet with Tennessee Tourism Commissioner Susan Whitaker, mayors from Shelby, Lauderdale and Fayette counties, and the Executive Director of the Covington-Tipton County Chamber at the unveiling of the West Tennessee 'Day Trippin' Campaign. The 'Day Trippin' Campaign includes a series of one-minute videos featuring the mayors of their respective communities, encouraging both residents and visitors to enjoy unique attractions off the beaten path..."all within a day trip of Memphis."

WHERE: Commissioner Whitaker and the mayors will kick off this historical event during a news conference held at the Crescent Club at 6075 Poplar Avenue, Suite 909, in Memphis.

WHEN: *Thursday, February 28, 2013.* The news conference will be held at **4:30 p.m.** to precede MAAG's 45th Annual Membership Meeting and Dinner.

WHY: The news conference on Thursday afternoon will officially unveil the West Tennessee Day Trippin Campaign, a new tourism and economic development program, to help the Greater Memphis region capture its market share of the \$15.36 Billion tourism industry in the state of Tennessee. The video series, produced by MAAG, is part of a five-year, \$159,250 endowment grant from the Tennessee Department of Tourist Development (TDTD).
