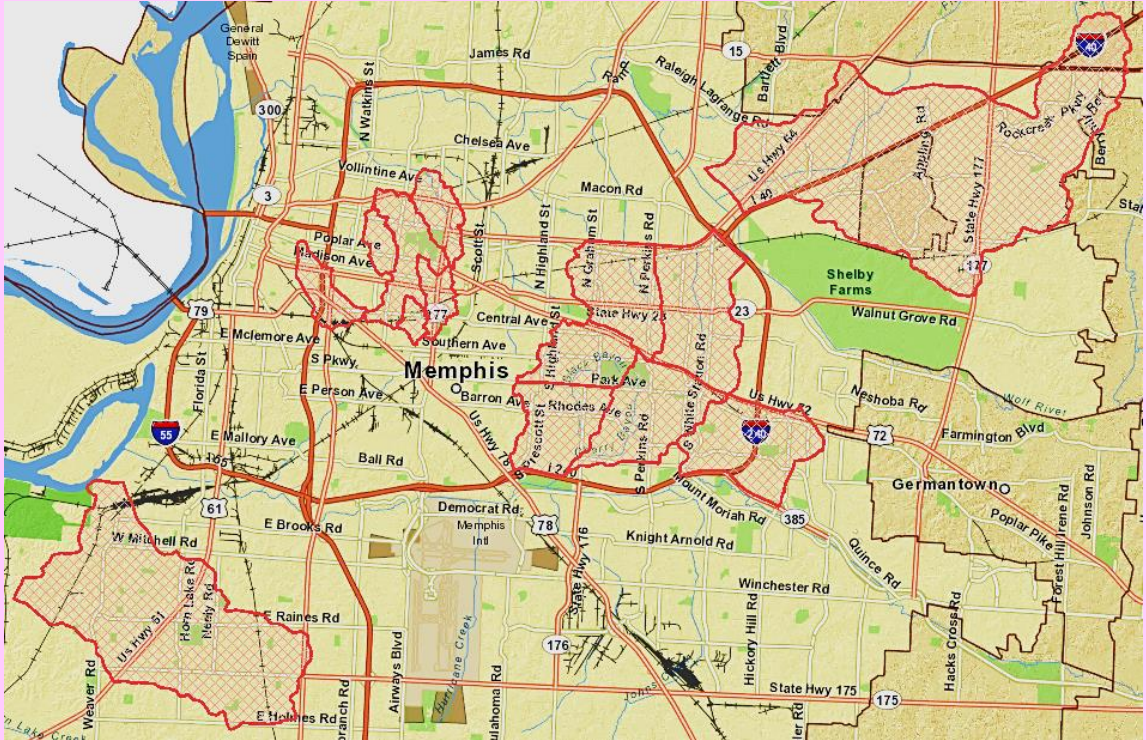




DO MY PLANS NEED TO BE REVIEWED BY ENGINEERING?
