Shelby County, TN – Excluding the Shelby County Trustee's Office at 157 Poplar Avenue, all Shelby County Government buildings located downtown will remain closed Tuesday, February 23rd due to limited plumbing from water pressure issues. When possible, Shelby County employees will work from home in accordance with the Shelby County Government Alternative Workplace Solutions policy.
