HEALTH DEPARTMENT'S VITAL RECORDS OFFICE OFFERS EXTENDED HOURS MONDAY, JUNE 21, 2021 AFTER JUNETEENTH HOLIDAY

SHELBY COUNTY, TN – The Shelby County Health Department's Vital Records Office located at 814 Jefferson Avenue will be closed on Friday, June 18, in observance of Juneteenth. The office will offer extended hours, from 8:00 AM till 6:00 PM, for customers on Monday, June 21, 2021.

The Office of Vital Records processes and maintains certified copies of certificates of birth and certificates of deaths that occurred in Shelby County, Tennessee.

The Shelby County Health Department encourages all residents to keep at least one copy of their birth certificate in a secure location. Keeping a copy of your birth certificate at home in a safe and accessible place gives you an easy way to verify your identity. A certificate of birth is necessary to obtain social security card, apply for a passport, enroll in schools, get a driver's license, gain employment, or apply for other benefits.
