

CHANCERY COURT DRESS CODE

FOR COURT APPEARANCES

The personal appearance and conduct of attorneys in the Courtroom in person or on Zoom are visible evidence of their respect for the rule of law and the administration of justice. All attorneys shall wear professional attire.

All other persons attending Court must conduct themselves with reserve and courtesy and must dress appropriately in a clean and neat appearance so as to preserve the dignity of the Court.

Unacceptable Attire (including, but not limited to):

- Articles of clothing containing words, slang, pictures, symbols, slogans or ethnic slurs – in general clothing with words or pictures are not allowed.
- Transparent/see-through, provocative, or revealing articles of clothing
- Skirts/dresses more than 3 inches above the knee
- T-shirts, shorts, short suits, spandex pants, skorts, leggings, jeggings, stretch pants, sweat suits, jogging or warm-up suits or jogging-styled pants.
- Ripped/torn jeans
- Strapless, off the shoulder, halter, backless, or spaghetti strap tops or dresses worn without a sweater or jacket
- Baseball caps/hats
- Flip flops, slides, house slippers
