The respondent has the right to:

1. Jury trial on the issues of disability on demand by the respondent or the guardian ad litem;
2. Present evidence and confront and cross-examine witnesses;
3. Appeal the final decision on the petition;
4. Attend any hearing;
5. Have an attorney ad litem appointed to advocate the interests of the respondent.
